## **THE IMPORTANCE OF SERIAL NUMBERS**

You must know the model serial number and VIN number for registration purposes and when ordering replacement parts.

The frame serial number is stamped on the right hand side of the steering head. The vehicle identification number (VIN) is on the left-hand side of the steering head. The engine serial number is located on the lower left hand side of the crankcase adjacent to the shift lever or on the top surface of the crankcase. The carburettor identification number is located on the carburettor body above the float bowl. On models so equipped, the colour label is attached to the frame next to the air filter box. When ordering colour coded parts always specify the colour indicated on this label

It is important to supply the correct serial/model number to the shop where you order your parts from. In most cases you cannot return genuine spare parts, as the Japanese and European manufacturers have a no parts return policy. Electrical parts are never ever accepted for return.

Keep a logbook with all your information on your bike in it, ie model number, and any other special information that will help you get the right parts. Also keep the history of your riding time and what maintenance you do.
